The Rating Process

Each Task 1 and Task 2 response is randomly assigned to 2 different raters, Each rater assesses the response in each of the 4 dimensions of the Performance Standards.

f a response receives very lifferent ratings from the first two raters, the system assigns it to a benchmark rater to be reassessed.

The test taker's Level is calculated electronically based on the assessments of 4-6 raters.

Common CELPIP Writing Mistakes

Mistake	What To Do Instead
Not developing the ideas in the question with specific details	Build on the content of the question with ideas from your imagination and/or life experience. For example, if the question says "your office," describe a particular type of office. If it says "your city," write about a real city that you are familiar with.
Being rude or sarcastic	Maintain a polite tone in your responses. Expressing frustration or disrespect toward raters will not benefit your score.
Using humour extensively	Take the question and the situation seriously. Extensive use of humour is risky, as it can often be interpreted as disrespectful or irrelevant.
Mentioning off-topic personal information, such as nationality or professional credentials	Demonstrate your English skills by writing an organized and relevant response that includes well-developed ideas, precise language, and complex grammar. Omit details that are unrelated to the question.
Using templates, such as memorized introductions and conclusions	Always write in your own words. Don't prepare any content in advance. In every sentence, include information that is specific to the question.
Inappropriate formatting (e.g., inconsistent spacing, incorrect symbols, typing in all lower or upper case)	Use proper paragraphing, spacing, capitalization, and punctuation. Familiarize yourself with a standard keyboard so that you will know where to find commonly used keys (shift, enter, etc.) and symbols (apostrophe, comma, etc.).
